A VISION STRATEGY FOR ST PAUL'S CHURCH 2012- 2017

1. Introduction

The Church Vision Strategy for 2012-2017 seeks to build on and progress the previous Vision Strategy (2007-2012). As a result our mission, core values and structure remain unchanged. Our purpose is still very clearly:

'Living Christ in Camberley'

Our core values are:

- **Belonging** - building caring relationships
- **Believing** - teaching and preaching salvation only through Jesus
- **Behaving** - living Christ-like lives
- **Becoming** - making life-long disciples
- ... Demonstrating God's love for all.

2. Vision Review Process

1. Formation of Vision Strategy Group in August 2011 with external chair, Revd Stephen Cox (Diocesan Mission Advisor).
2. Congregational and Community Surveys (January 2012), followed by detailed analysis.
3. PCC and Ministry Co-ordinators consultation day (March 2012).
4. Draft Vision Statements 2012-2017 produced by Steering Group and presented to PCC (April 2012).
5. Congregational Consultation (May 2012) and feedback.
6. Final approval of revised Vision Statements by PCC (July 2012)
7. Revised Vision Strategy to be launched (September 2012)

3. Draft Vision Statements 2012-2017

1. At St Paul's we will grow our Congregational List by at least 50 people by 2017.
2. St Paul's will be a place where everyone, without exception, is welcome to belong to our community, where they will be known by name and valued for who they are.
3. St Paul's will be a place where all our relationships will reflect the love, the acceptance, the commitment and the faithfulness of Jesus.
4. At St Paul's the unchurched will find a place to belong.
5. St Paul's will be a place where we serve the people in Camberley as we would serve Christ himself.
6. St Paul's will be a place where we will nurture each other to live Christ 24/7.
7. St Paul's will provide an encouraging environment for the assembled church to give and receive from the Living God.
8. St Paul's will be a place where speaking and listening to God is essential to our very existence.
